Overview

This bill appropriates \$4 million in fiscal year 2020 and \$4 million in fiscal year 2021 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for community action grants.

A community action program is a community based and operated program which is designed to include a sufficient number of projects or components to provide, in sum, a range of services and activities having a measurable and potentially major impact on causes of poverty in the community or those areas of the community where poverty is a particularly acute problem.
