Overview

This bill clarifies and extends timelines for family child care providers to complete training in first aid, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), sudden unexpected infant death and abusive head trauma, child passenger restraint systems, and supervising for safety. The bill also lowers the age that triggers the child passenger restraint systems training requirement, from nine years old to eight years old, and makes these changes effective September 30, 2019.
