Overview

Adds next generation technology to the list of industries that the commissioner of labor and industry must develop competency standards for, which also makes such occupations eligible for dual-competency training grants under Minnesota Statutes, section 136A.246. Appropriates \$100,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$100,000 in fiscal year 2021 from the general fund for developing competency standards for dual training in occupations in next generation technology.
