## 1 City of Austin; on-sale license.

Section 1 allows the city of Austin to issue an on-sale wine or malt liquor license for events at the Riverside Arena. The license may be issued to the owner of a junior hockey league team or a person holding a concessions contract with the owner or the city.

## 2 City of Rochester; on-sale license.

Section 2 allows the city of Rochester to issue an on-sale wine or malt liquor license for events at the Rochester Recreation Arena. The license may be issued to the owner of a junior hockey league team or a person holding a concessions contract with the owner or the city.
