- Subject Electric vehicles
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Overview

House File 2233 provides \$15 million to fund grants to purchasers of qualifying electric vehicles, and \$3 million for grants to help fund a network of electric vehicle charging stations.

1	[216C.401] Electric vehicle rebates. Subd. 1. Definitions.
	Subd. 2. Eligibility. Establishes eligibility criteria for electric vehicles (not modified from OEM specifications; purchased after this act's effective date) and purchasers (Minnesota resident, business, nonprofit, or political subdivision located in Minnesota; has not previously received a Minnesota tax credit or rebate for an electric vehicle; registers the vehicle in Minnesota).
	Subd. 3. Rebate amounts. Sets rebate amounts at \$2,500 for a new and \$500 for a used electric vehicle.
	Subd. 4. Limits. Caps rebates at one per resident per household and one per business per year. Vehicles priced above \$60,000 are not eligible for a rebate.
	Subd. 5. Program administration. Directs the commissioner of commerce to develop administrative procedures governing the application and rebate award process.
	Subd. 6. Expiration. Provides that this section expires June 30, 2024.
2	[216C.402] Electric vehicle public charging grant program. Subd. 1. Definitions.
	Subd. 2. Program. Establishes a program under which the commissioner of commerce awards grants to help fund the installation of a network of public

electric vehicle charging stations.

3 Appropriation.

Appropriates \$7.5 million in fiscal year 2020 from the general fund for rebates to electric vehicle purchasers located outside Xcel Energy's electric service area under section 1.

Appropriates \$7.5 million in fiscal year 2020 from the renewable development account to electric vehicle purchasers located within Xcel Energy's electric service area under section 1.

Appropriates \$1.5 million in fiscal year 2020 from the general fund for grants to install electric vehicle charging stations in areas located outside Xcel Energy's electric service area under section 2, with special consideration given to locating charging stations in state parks.

Appropriates \$1.5 million from the renewable development account for grants to install electric vehicle charging stations in areas located within Xcel Energy's electric service area under section 2.



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
