Overview

This bill allows the commissioner of human services to grant a licensing variance for individuals providing nonemergency medical transportation services, if more than 40 years have passed since the discharge of a criminal sentence for a crime or conduct that would otherwise warrant a permanent disqualification from direct contact services.
