Overview

This bill would allow a person to use night vision or thermal imaging equipment to hunt fox or coyote and establish enhanced consequences for those using the equipment while in violation of certain game and fish laws.

Summary

Section	Description
1	Issuance after conviction; night vision or thermal imaging equipment.
	Prohibits a person convicted of trespassing, hunting out of season, or hunting outside of legal hours from obtaining a hunting license or hunting wild animals for five years if the person possessed night vision or thermal imaging equipment when the violation occurred.
2	Possessing night vision or thermal imaging equipment.

Allows a person legally hunting coyote or fox to use night vision or thermal imaging equipment.
