

Subject Housing Supports Supplemental Rate

Overview

This bill provides for a housing support provider in Anoka County to receive a supplemental rate.

Housing support (formerly known as Group Residential Housing) is a state-funded income supplement program administered by DHS that pays for room and board costs for low-income adults residing in a licensed or registered setting with which a county human services agency has negotiated a monthly rate. Recipients in certain settings may also qualify for a supplemental payment that is in addition to the housing support basic room and board rate.

1	<p>Supplemental rate; Anoka County.</p> <p>Amends § 256I.05, subd. 1r. Beginning July 1, 2019, requires the county agency to negotiate a supplemental rate not to exceed \$400 per month, including any legislatively authorized inflationary adjustments, for a housing support provider located in Anoka County that operates a 12-bed facility and provides housing support and supplementary services to individuals 24 years of age and younger.</p>
