Overview

This bill relates to light rail transit service and evaluation of healthy food options at the Twin Cities campus of the University of Minnesota.

Summary

Section Description

1 Campus zone pass.

Requires expansion of the existing campus zone pass program for light rail transit to include at least one additional stop (beyond the three stops located on the University of Minnesota Twin Cities campus), with costs of the expansion split evenly between the Metropolitan Council and the university.

2 Campus zone pass costs assessment.

Directs the Metropolitan Council to provide a legislative report by February 1, 2021, on the costs of the campus zone pass program.

3 Healthy food availability study.

Appropriates an amount to be determined from the general fund in fiscal year 2021 to the University of Minnesota for an evaluation of healthy food availability on and near the Twin Cities campus.
