Summary

This bill provides \$50 million to the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency to pay for the construction, acquisition, and rehabilitation of short-term housing facilities for individuals and families without a permanent residence.

\$25 million is provided from housing infrastructure bond proceeds authorized in the bill, and \$25 million is appropriated from the general fund.
