# **Overview**

Section 626A.42 prohibits a government entity from obtaining location information from an electronic device without a warrant unless one of the listed exceptions applies. This bill expands the scope of tracking warrants to include identifying information associated with a single entity or account within an application or service that may be used on multiple devices.

#### 1 Definitions.

Defines "unique identifier" as any numeric or alphanumeric string that is associated with a single entity or account within a given electronic communication application or service.

# 2 Tracking warrant required for location information.

Permits the use of a tracking warrant or the applicable exceptions to obtain information on a unique identifier.
