Summary

This bill modifies information that must be provided by a driver who is involved in a motor vehicle collision involving injury or damage, so that (1) either a mailing address or an email address must be given (instead of just a mailing address), and (2) a driver's license or permit does not have to be shown to other individuals involved in the collision. It is effective August 1, 2020.
