## **Overview**

This bill modifies requirements for temporary motor vehicle permits, including to change the location where the permit must be displayed. The changes are effective August 1, 2020.

# **Summary**

# Section Description

#### 1 Display of temporary permit.

Modifies the location to display a temporary permit issued in conjunction with expired registration, to be where a license plate is normally displayed instead of in the rear window. Requires the permit to be plainly visible.

## 2 31-day temporary vehicle permit.

Modifies the location to display a 31-day temporary permit (issued to nonresidents for transporting the vehicle out of state), to be affixed to the rear of the vehicle instead of in the rear window. Removes a requirement that dealers provide information on permit issuances to the Department of Public Safety.

## 3 **21-day temporary vehicle permit.**

Modifies the location to display a 21-day temporary permit (issued for vehicle purchases), to be where a license plate is normally displayed instead of in the rear window. Requires the permit to be plainly visible. Eliminates a dealer recordkeeping requirement.
