Summary

Section Description

1 Registration revocation and suspension; degree-granting schools.

Requires the Office of Higher Education (OHE) to give written notice and reasons before revoking, suspending, or refusing to renew registration or approval of a school's degree.

Permits OHE to revoke or suspend approval of a degree-granting school if the school:

- Used fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices.
- Demonstrated incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility.
- Was administratively or judicially determined to have committed fraud or a material violation of law involving state, local, or federal funds.
- 2 License revocation and suspension; private career schools.

Permits OHE to revoke or suspend approval of a private career school if the school:

- Used fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices.
- Demonstrated incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility.
- Was administratively or judicially determined to have committed fraud or a material violation of law involving state, local, or federal funds.
