

**Subject** County highway speed limits

## Summary

This bill authorizes counties to set speed limits on county roads under their respective jurisdictions, without prior traffic analysis and authorization by the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT). The county must develop procedures for setting speed limits based on its safety, engineering, and traffic analysis. A county is not authorized under the provision to change speed limits on other road systems (such as trunk highways or city streets).

It is effective August 1, 2020.
