Overview

This bill appropriates \$3 million in fiscal year 2020 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for grants to existing live well at home grantees to continue services during the COVID-19 outbreak.

Summary

Section Description

1 Appropriation; live well at home grants.

Paragraph (a) appropriates \$3 million in fiscal year 2020 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services for live well at home grants to continue services during the COVID-19 outbreak.

Paragraph (b) specifies the commissioner's duties in distributing these funds, including distributing the funds to existing grantees as of March 13, 2020.

Paragraph (c) waives local match requirements for funds distributed under this section.

Paragraph (d) allows the commissioner to use up to three percent of this appropriation for administrative expenses.

Paragraph (e) specifies this is a onetime appropriation and is available until June 30, 2021. Requires grantees to return to the commissioner any unexpended funds as of June 30, 2021. Requires all unexpended funds returned to the commissioner to be deposited in the general fund.

Provides an immediate effective date.
