Summary

Adds grandparent, stepparent, stepchild, uncle, aunt, nephew, and niece to the list of qualifying relatives for agricultural relative homestead. Under current law, agricultural relative homestead may be granted if a parent, sibling, child, or grandchild of the owner is occupying the property. This change would mean that qualifying relatives are the same for agricultural relative homesteads and residential relative homesteads.
