Summary

This bill, as amended, repeals administrative rules requiring an assessment of need for a new chemical dependency treatment or rehabilitation program and requiring a county board to submit a statement to the commissioner regarding the need for the new program. It also removes statutory references to the repealed rules, and adds a requirement for an applicant for substance use disorder treatment program licensure to notify the county human services director in writing of their intent to open a new program, at least 60 days before submitting a licensure application.
