Summary

H.F. 2132 would allow a municipality to authorize an on-sale licensee to serve alcoholic beverages at an outdoor, noncontiguous location, notwithstanding the requirement that licenses must be issued for compact and contiguous spaces.

The municipality's authorization must specify the outdoor premises, and require the premises to be demarcated. The licensee would be required to demonstrate control over the premises and that the premises is covered by liability insurance.
