Summary

H.F. 3070 would allow a municipality to issue one additional temporary on-sale intoxicating liquor license to a county agricultural society, for sales of alcoholic beverages at a county fair. The license would authorize sales for seven days. Under current law, the maximum duration of these licenses is four days.
