## Summary

Currently, applicants for podiatry licensure who graduated from podiatric medical school before 1986 do not need to present evidence of successful completion of an approved podiatric residency program in order to be licensed. This bill modifies the licensing requirements to allow podiatrists who graduated from podiatric medical school before 1990 to be licensed without successful completion of such a residency program.
