### **Overview**

This bill modifies requirements related to obtaining the contents of a vehicle that has been towed to an impound lot.

# **Summary**

## **Section Description**

### 1 Nonpublic operator.

Defines "nonpublic operator" in the chapter of statutes on motor vehicle towing, to be a private operator of an impound lot, including private operators who maintain a public impound lot under a contract with a local unit of government.

### 2 Waiting period extension.

Extends the waiting period by an additional 15 days until a towed vehicle or its contents can be disposed of, when a nonpublic impound lot operator denies a vehicle owner's request to retrieve towed vehicle contents and the denial is within 15 days of the end of the original 45-day waiting period.

### 3 **Payment of charges.**

Makes conforming changes.

#### 4 Retrieval of contents.

Adds proof of identity to the documentation to be presented when a vehicle owner seeks to retrieve towed vehicle contents. Requires nonpublic impound lot operators to give specific written reasons when denying a vehicle owner's request to retrieve the contents of a towed vehicle.

### 5 Remedy.

Paragraph (a) explicitly allows for a civil suit by the vehicle owner when a private impound lot operator does not release towed vehicle contents, including for attorney fees.

### **Section Description**

Paragraph (b) establishes an additional liability of \$1,000 damages, plus attorney fees, against a nonpublic impound lot operator who violates the content retrieval or extended waiting period provisions.
