Summary

This bill is a memorial resolution to Congress, requesting that the South St. Paul Post Office be named in memory of Officer Leo Pavlak. As described in the resolution, Officer Pavlak was shot and killed outside the post office during a robbery on August 30, 1933.

The naming of post offices is a responsibility of the federal government; if approved, this resolution would be forwarded to the President of the United States, and officers of the United States House of Representatives and Senate, and Minnesota's Senators and Representatives in Congress.
