

Subject Higher Education: Office of Higher Education (OHE) Agency Bill

Overview

This is OHE's agency bill. It contains changes related to the administration of OHE programs.

Summary

Section	Description
1	State grant program: data. Clarifies that data on student enrollment and federal and state financial aid only needs to be provided if the institution's students are eligible to receive state financial aid.
2	SELF loans: data. Clarifies that data on student enrollment and federal and state financial aid only needs to be provided if the institution's students are eligible to receive SELF loans. Also requires registered private and out-of-state public postsecondary institutions and licensed career schools to submit data under this section.
3	Private career schools: exemptions. Makes changes to the list of institutions exempt from the requirements of the Private Career Schools Act.
4	Concurrent enrollment grants: grants. Amends the requirements for a postsecondary institution using grant funds to expand its existing concurrent enrollment programs.
5	Concurrent enrollment grants: application. Corrects an error in the statute by striking a reference to a provision that does not exist.

Section	Description
6	<p data-bbox="316 262 446 294">Repealer.</p> <p data-bbox="316 304 1427 535">Repeals a part in Minnesota Rules, chapter 4880 (regarding private career schools) that splits the schools into two categories and imposes different relicensure requirements. The underlying statute supporting this rule, section 136A.823, subdivision 2, was repealed in the 2021 higher education omnibus act. Note that most of chapter 141 has been renumbered as section 136A.82–834, the “Private Career School Act.”</p>
