



Subject Capitol Area Security Advisory Committee

Summary

This bill removes an existing sunset date on the Advisory Committee on Capitol Area Security. The advisory committee is currently scheduled to expire June 30, 2022.

The advisory committee was first enacted in 2012, and is required to meet at least quarterly to assess current safety and security risks in the Capitol area, and discuss developments that might affect those risks in the future. The lieutenant governor serves as chair of the committee. The membership also includes two senators, two members of the house, and the chief justice of the Minnesota Supreme Court (or the chief justice's designee).
