Overview

This bill appropriates \$14,500,000 annually from fiscal year 2022 to fiscal year 2026 for grants to Heading Home Ramsey Continuum of Care to fund shelter programming, the maintenance and replacement of shelter facilities, and the development and operation of a familiar faces pilot program for frequently unhoused clients.

Summary

Section Description

1 Appropriation; Heading Home Ramsey Continuum of Care.

Appropriates \$14,500,000 from the general fund to the commissioner of human services in each of fiscal years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025, and 2026 for a grant to Heading Home Ramsey Continuum of Care. Allows the grant to be used for: maintaining a shelter facility previously funded by the CARES act; maintaining and replacing a 100-bed single-room occupancy shelter for single adults; developing and operating a familiar faces pilot program for high-frequency unhoused clients; maintaining day shelter programming previously funded by the CARES act; and replacing current day shelter facilities. Allows Ramsey County to contract with nonprofits and Tribal and local governments to provide services. Allows Ramsey County to use 10 percent of appropriated funds for administrative expenses.
