Summary

In 2004, the legislature passed a law that generally prohibits ownership or possession in Minnesota of regulated animals such as lions, cheetahs, bears, and gorillas. The law includes a few exceptions, including zoos that are accredited by the American Zoo and Aquarium Association.

H.F. 4166 would expand this exception to include zoos accredited by the Zoological Association of America.
