Summary

H.F. 4226 expands the Minnesota renter's credit in three ways:

- Increases the income limitation for the credit from \$68,440 to \$90,000. Renters with household incomes in that range would be eligible for a maximum credit from \$300 to \$700.
- Reduces co-pay percentages by 5 percentage points, for renters with household incomes between \$46,920 and \$68,440.
- Increases maximum refunds for renters with incomes between \$60,630 and \$68,440 by \$60 to \$670.
