## **Overview**

This bill would create a grant program to install sprinklers in high-rises owned by nonprofits and occupied primarily by persons meeting certain income thresholds. This bill appropriates \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency (MHFA) to fund the program.

## **Section Description**

1 High-rise sprinkler grant program.

**Subd. 1. Definitions.** Defines terms for the purposes of the program, including "eligible building" as one where: (1) at least one story used for human occupancy is 75 feet or more above the lowest level of fire department vehicle access; and (2) at least two-thirds of its units are occupied by households at or below 50 percent of area median income.

**Subd. 2. Grant program.** Requires MHFA to operate a grant program awarding grants to nonprofits to install sprinkler systems in eligible buildings owned by the nonprofits.

**Subd. 3. Appropriation.** Appropriates \$5,000,000 in fiscal year 2023 from the general fund to MHFA to fund the program. Provides that the money is available until expended.

**Subd. 4. Expiration.** Sets an expiration date for the program of June 30, 2025.
