Summary

This bill appropriates \$600,000 in FY 22 and \$400,000 in FY 23 to the commissioner of public safety. \$400,000 each year is for grants to law enforcement agencies to deliver training to prepare peace officers to work with citizens suffering from dementia and Alzheimer's disease. \$200,000 in FY 22 is to increase membership, reduce the registration fee, and create additional alert categories for the criminal alert network.
