Subject County and tribal overpayment reimbursement

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Summary

This bill appropriates money from the general fund to the commissioner of human services to reimburse counties and tribes for overpayments of federal funds that are now owed.

Paragraph (a) appropriates \$8,812,000 in fiscal year 2022, as a onetime appropriation, to the commissioner to reimburse counties for the statewide county share of costs for which federal funds were claimed, but were not eligible for federal funding for substance use disorder services provided in institutions for mental disease (IMD), for claims paid between January 1, 2014, and June 30, 2019. It requires the commissioner to allocate the funds proportionally, and requires the counties to fully pay any unpaid consolidated chemical dependency treatment fund invoiced county share before receiving a reimbursement.

Paragraph (b) appropriates \$28,908,000 in fiscal year 2022, as a onetime appropriation, to the commissioner for grants to the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe and White Earth Band of Chippewa to repay overpayments for medication assisted treatment services between fiscal year 2014 and fiscal year 2019, and specifies the grant amounts for each tribe.
