Summary

This bill grants the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA) additional time to use \$60,000 of federal COVID-19 aid to provide additional Farm Advocates services in response to the COVID-19 crisis. The bill also requires MDA to report by January 31, 2022, regarding the agency's use of these dollars.
