Overview

This bill requires school districts and charter schools to implement a comprehensive sexual health education program in elementary and secondary schools, and requires the commissioner of education to develop a model program that school districts and charter schools can implement.

Summary

Section Description

1 Sexual health education.

Subd. 1. Model program. Requires the commissioner of education to develop one or more model comprehensive sexual health education programs for elementary and secondary school students. Lists required topics for model program.

Subd. 2. School programs. Requires school districts and charter schools to implement a comprehensive sexual health education program starting in the 2023-2024 school year for students in elementary and secondary school. Lists requirements for sexual health education program.

Subd. 3. Parental review. Requires a district or charter school to comply with statutory parental curriculum review requirements.

2 Sexual health education report.

Requires the commissioner of education to report to the legislature on the sexual health education program.
