Summary

This bill directs the Metropolitan Council to use its lowest emission buses on regular bus routes that serve areas identified as having poor air quality.

The council must coordinate with the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency to determine locations with low air quality and must categorize its bus fleet based on estimated emissions impacts. The analysis must be revised every three years. The requirements do not apply to arterial and highway bus rapid transit.
