Overview

The bill classifies as private certain public transportation customer data collected and maintained by the Metropolitan Council.

Summary

Section Description

1 Transit customer data.

Classifies as private any data collected by telephone or third-party software (i.e. a mobile app) regarding transit customers' booking and use of public transit services.

2 Transit assistance program data.

Classifies as private any data on users of metropolitan transit assistance programs. Permits the Metropolitan Council to disclose the data for purposes of coordinating programs and services for users.

3 Transit disadvantage.

Adds a cross-reference to the data classification in section 2 of the bill.

4 Effective data; application.

States that the bill is effective the day following final enactment and applies in the metropolitan area.
