Overview

This bill clarifies a private right of action for individuals and farmers in certain types of consumer protective actions related to fraud.

Summary

Section Description

1 Private enforcement.

Provides that an individual or family farmer can bring a private right of action under the consumer protection statute, sections 325F.68 to 325F.70, to which the attorney general is currently able to enforce, and also that the action is deemed to be for the public benefit. This section would be effective August 1, 2023, and applies to causes of action commenced on or after that day.
