Overview

This bill modifies the information collected in consumer surveys for home and community-based services and requires licensed assisted living facilities to participate in resident experience surveys and family surveys when requested by the commissioner.

Summary

Section Description

1 Contact and demographic information for consumer surveys for home and community-based services.

Amends § 256B.439, subd. 3c. Allows the commissioner to request aggregate, deidentified demographic information of clients served by a provider. Lists the demographic information the commissioner may request including age and gender identity.

2 Resident experience survey and family survey for assisted living facilities.

Amends § 256B.439, subd. 3d. Requires licensed assisted living facilities to participate in resident experience surveys and family surveys when requested by the commissioner.
