

Subject Metropolitan Council redistricting

Summary

The Minnesota legislature is required by Minnesota Statutes, section 473.123, subdivision 3a, to redraw the boundaries of Metropolitan Council districts every ten years after each decennial federal census. Such redistricting is to be effective in the year ending in the numeral “3.” Accordingly, the legislature must redraw the Metropolitan Council district boundaries in 2023.

This bill identifies the redistricting map for Metropolitan Council districts if this bill was enacted into law. Minnesota Statutes, section 473.123, subdivision 3e, which provides the current Metropolitan Council district boundaries, would be repealed.

This act applies in the counties of Anoka, Carver, Dakota, Hennepin, Ramsey, Scott, and Washington and is effective the day following final enactment.
