## Summary

This bill modifies the definition of “noncovered employment” in existing law to add employment by a foreign agricultural worker on a temporary H-2A visa. Employers would not pay unemployment insurance taxes on the wages of a temporary agricultural worker on an H-2A visa, and such wages would not be included in the worker’s wage credits for the purposes of unemployment insurance.
