Subject Establishing a felony offense for directing an emergency response to

the homes of certain individuals

Overview

Under current law it is a crime to report a false emergency with the intent of having emergency responders respond to the false report. The severity of the crime depends on whether the person making the call has a prior offense and whether anyone is injured during the response.

This bill establishes a felony consequence if the person places the call with the intent of prompting an emergency response to the home of an elected official, judge, prosecuting attorney, employee of a correctional facility, or peace officer.

Summary

Section Description

1 Felony offense; reporting fictitious emergency resulting in response to the home of certain officials.

Establishes a felony penalty of up to one year in prison, a fine of \$5,000, or both if a person reports a false emergency and does so with the intent that emergency responders go to the home of an elected official, judge, prosecuting attorney, employee of a correctional facility, or peace officer.
