

Subject Unauthorized Presence on Military Installations

Summary

This bill would establish misdemeanor and felony crimes for intentional, unauthorized presence at any campground, military reservation, armory, installation, or facility owned or controlled by the state or federal government for military purposes. Under current law, these crimes apply only to intentional, unauthorized presence at Camp Ripley.

H.F. 3871 also removes the requirement that a person know that entry in an area restricted for weapon firing or another hazardous military activity creates a risk of death, bodily harm, or serious property damage to constitute a felony.
