Overview

This bill modifies a consumer protection law requiring that repair shops provide a written estimate for work that will cost more than \$100. The bill removes an exemption from the written estimate requirement for work costing over \$7,500.

Requires retailers to conspicuously display a sign stating that the shop is required to provide a written estimate for repairs costing more than \$100 and that the final price cannot exceed the written estimate by more than ten percent. |
