

Subject Targeted case management; county contracts

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Overview

This bill requires county boards that contract with other individuals or agencies to provide adult mental health targeted case management services to initiate a competitive proposal process at least every two years.

Adult mental health targeted case management services help adults with serious and persistent mental illness access needed medical, social, educational, vocational, and other necessary services related to the client's mental health needs.

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Amends § 245.466, subd. 3. Removes obsolete language. Requires a county board to initiate a competitive proposal process for the procurement of contracted case management services at least every two years if the county board provides case management under contract with other individuals or agencies. Requires the competitive proposal process to include evaluation criteria to ensure that the county maintains a culturally specific program for case management services adequate to meet the needs of the county population.

Provides an August 1, 2024, effective date, and applies this change to contracts entered into or renewed on or after that date.
