

Subject School Aid to Improve Student Attendance

Overview

H.F. 4912 appropriates \$20 million on a onetime basis for Minnesota's school districts to improve student attendance. Provides aid to each school district, charter school, and cooperative unit. Sets the aid for school districts and charter schools equal to \$20 times the district's fall 2023 student enrollment. Sets the aid for a cooperative unit equal to \$2 times the total student enrollment in all of its member districts.

Requires the onetime aid to be used for programs that build connections to students and encourage regular school attendance.

| 1 | <p>Appropriations; student attendance.</p> <p>Appropriates \$20 million in fiscal year 2025 for aid to school districts for measures to improve student attendance. Sets the aid amount at \$20 per student for school districts and charter schools and, for cooperatives, sets the aid equal to \$2 times the total student enrollment of the cooperative's member school districts. Allows the schools to spend the money over a three-year period.</p> |
