Summary

Section Description

1 [325E.80] Abnormal market disruptions; unconscionably excessive prices.

Subd. 1. Definitions. Defines "abnormal market disruption," "essential consumer good or service," and "unconscionably excessive."

Subd. 2. Prohibition. Prohibits a person from selling or offering to sell an essential consumer good or service for an unconscionably excessive price during an abnormal market disruption.

Subd. 3. Civil Penalty. Subjects a person who violates this section to a civil penalty of up to \$10,000 per sale or transaction.

Subd. 4. Enforcement authority. Allows the attorney general to investigate violations of this section and to use all powers under section 8.31.

Effective date. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
