## Summary

This bill would appropriate \$1 million per year to the Minnesota Department of Agriculture for grants to support the work of county agricultural inspectors in counties that satisfy the criteria specified in the bill.

Under the Minnesota Noxious Weed Law (Minn. Stat. ch. 18), counties must appoint at least one county agricultural inspector or county-designated employee to enforce state noxious weed laws.
