| 1 | <p><b>[Adds § 168.1283] Rotary International plates.</b><br/>Establishes a Rotary International special license plate and provides for plate issuance.</p> <p><b>Subd. 1. Issuance of plates.</b> Provides for issuance of the special plate if specified conditions are met, which includes ownership of a qualifying type of vehicle, payment of fees and taxes, and donations to a Rotary International account (at \$25 on initial plate application and \$5 annually).</p> <p><b>Subd. 2. Design.</b> Specifies plate design.</p> <p><b>Subd. 3. Plates transfer.</b> Provides for transfer of the special plates to another qualifying vehicle.</p> <p><b>Subd. 4. Exemption.</b> Exempts the special plates from various plate application requirements.</p> <p><b>Subd. 5. Fees.</b> Specifies allocation of fee revenue.</p> <p><b>Subd. 6. Contributions; account; appropriation.</b> Creates a Rotary Foundation account in the special revenue fund, which receives the annual donations. Makes a statutory appropriation of account funds for administrative costs and distribution to the Rotary Foundation.</p> |
