Overview

The Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board reimburses ambulance services for the costs of volunteer ambulance attendants to complete emergency medical technician (EMT) education courses. This bill increases the maximum amounts an ambulance service may receive for completion of initial education courses and continuing education courses by volunteer ambulance attendants.

Section Description

1 Reimbursement to ambulance services for volunteer education costs.

Amends § 144E.35. Increases the maximum amounts that an ambulance service may be reimbursed by the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board for costs for volunteer ambulance attendants to complete EMT education courses, from \$600 to \$900 for an initial education course, and from \$275 to \$375 for a continuing education course.
