## Summary

This bill names the Bill and Bonnie Daniels Firefighters Hall and Museum as the "official state fire museum" for Minnesota. The facility is located in Northeast Minneapolis. It serves as an event center as well as a museum showcasing a variety of historic fire service exhibitions and artifacts from around Minnesota.

Minnesota's existing statutes recognize at least 17 items as "official" state symbols, based on various aspects of the state's history, natural resources, and culture. Most recently, the rusty patched bumble bee was designated as the official state bee, in 2019.
