## **Overview**

This bill modifies citizenship requirements for the Minnesota family investment program (MFIP) by allowing noncitizens who are victims of a severe form of trafficking or who have suffered substantial physical or mental abuse as a result of having been a victim of criminal activity to be eligible for MFIP.

MFIP is a jointly funded, federal-state program that provides income assistance to eligible low-income families. MFIP is partly funded by temporary assistance for needy families (TANF), a federal block grant program to states.
